St. Mary's Preschool Program

St. Mary's offers an early childhood program for children three, four and five years of age. The goal of the school is to promote the spiritual, social, emotional and intellectual development of each child in a nurturing atmosphere with Catholic values.

Our students are exposed to a range of classroom experiences including, music, art, dramatic play, reading, building, exploration, dancing and language designed to stimulate their creativity, physical development, and problem solving abilities. The teacher and children gather each day for group learning opportunities designed to enhance each child's cognition, perception, and communication skills. Personalized instruction is provided on a daily basis so that each child receives a challenging and engaging education. The program includes pre-reading, math and religious education curriculums. We promote positive participation in our school community, respect for fellow students and teachers, and helping one another. Our goal is to help each child grow their sense of self-worth and well-being and always encourages the positive "I can" attitude.

St. Mary's Catholic Prekindergarten:

- Wears uniforms
- Is licensed by the Maryland Department of Education's Office of Childcare

We believe that a successful parent-teacher partnership is critical to giving your child the best preschool experience. We encourage frequent communication and welcome parent participation.

Parent Involvement

Each family is encouraged to assist and participate in the preschool program. It is always interesting to see a classroom in action and to see your own child interacting with other children and away from home. The school uses volunteers for field trips, classroom special occasions, school celebrations, coordinating parent socials, and many other events. We are so grateful for the wonderful support our parents provide to enhance our school community. Parents with special skills, talents, hobbies or places of work suitable for field trips are encouraged to bring this to the attention of the teacher.

Parent-Teacher Communication

There is a general orientation meeting in August that parents are asked to attend. Conferences will be held in November. Report Cards are distributed in January and June for families enrolled in the four year old classes. The three year old students will receive a written evaluation at the spring conference. If you have any questions about your child and his or her progress, please remember you may call or email a teacher and request an appointment to meet with the teacher. Teacher contact information is posted on the St. Mary's School website.

Any parent who has any contact with the children must be in complete compliance with the Archdiocesan Child Protection Policies. All volunteers are required to complete the Archdiocesan Child Protection Virtus Training, have criminal background checks, and complete necessary paperwork.
